

37 **BERLIOZ, HECTOR.** (1803-1869) French Composer. ALS, 1p, 4to, Vienna 26, nd, ny. In French, circa 1845, to Mr Rety, Cashier of the Conservatory of Music, Paris. Berlioz writes, in part: *"...My first concert took place Sunday with all the success I could wish for; they applauded me, and encored and recalled me endlessly. The second [concert] takes place the day after tomorrow; following this I will go to Pesth or Prague..."*. He adds in a postscript: *"I am going to a rehearsal..."* Excellent music content. Light age toning, but in fine condition. Signed "Berlioz" \$1,250

38. **MANET, EDOUARD.** (1832-1883) Eminent French Impressionist Artist. One of the founders of the Impressionist School. ALS, 1p, 8vo, nd, Tuesday, ny, in French, to the art critic Zacharie Astruc regarding his friend Abbot Hurel who is an officiate at the Magdaleine Church in Paris. Manet writes: *"My dear Zacharie, Abbot Hurel is going to make a trip to Spain. He would be very grateful to you if you would make a detailed itinerary. He wants to go as far as Malaga. Would you have lunch with me next Friday at noon? I will write to you both from home and you can talk it over. Regards, E. Manet."* Manet has added on top of the page: *"Here is your letter fortunately I have not sent it."* Letters of Manet are uncommon as he died younger than the other Impressionist painters. \$1,950

39 **FORD, GERALD.** (b.1913) 38th US President. Signed FDC with picture of White House and US Flag, postmarked May 30, 1969, Chicago, IL. Signed "Gerald Ford" \$75

40. **CHAGALL, MARC.** (1889-1985) Russian-born French Expressionist Artist. Signed reproduction of one of his colorful paintings picturing a large red donkey head and a Russian farmer on a sled. Superb. (Illustr.) \$195

41. **LONGFELLOW, HENRY W** (1807-1882) Eminent American Poet. Poems include *The Children's Hour* and *Paul Revere's Ride* From 1836 until his death Longfellow lived at Craige House in Cambridge, from which our letter was written. ALS, 1p, 8vo, Cambridge, March 12, 1869 In full. *"Dear Sir It gives me great pleasure to comply with your request and to send you an autograph, which you will find enclosed. Yours truly, Henry W Longfellow."* \$220

42. **CARUSO, ENRICO.** (1873-1921) Great Italian Tenor Original signed drawing in ink. Caruso has drawn a caricature face with a double chin on a 5x7" linen paper, with a bold large signature "Enrico Caruso 1920" drawn and signed a few months before his death. \$785

43. **LLOYD GEORGE, DAVID.** (1863-1945) British Prime Minister During WW I. Brilliant Statesman of the 20th Century A controversial politician involved in the Marconi Scandal. He also lived openly with his secretary while married. Became War Secretary and then Prime Minister Represented Britain at the Versailles Peace Conference as one of the "Big Four" TLS, 1p, 4to, 14 June 1929, on his personalized stationary *"...I acknowledge your letter and thank you for your good wishes..."* Boldly signed "D. Lloyd George." \$145



44. **GANDHI, MAHATMA.** (Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi) (1869-1948) Indian non-violent nationalist leader Gandhi's philosophy and advocacy of non-violence (partly derived from Hindu writings, Thoreau, and the New Testament) was successful in accomplishing what 400 million Indians had not achieved through their armed uprisings for 150 years: getting the British out of India. Rare signed printed photo, in color.

31. **BALL, LUCILLE and ARNAZ, DESI.** Famed husband and wife comedy actors of *I Love Lucy*. Vintage ISP 8x10" [circa 1940's], b/w, of a young Lucy and Desi on their farm with western clothes. Lucy Ball has inscribed and signed in light area. "*For Richard, Love Lucy*" and Desi Arnaz has signed "*Desi*" Rare in early vintage photos signed by both \$575

32. **COOPER, GARY** (1901-1960) Handsome American actor. Signed photo, 8vo b/w A young Cooper standing in formal attire. Boldly signed. "*Sincerely, Gary Cooper*" Pristine. \$345

HEMINGWAY IN THE "GREEN HILLS OF AFRICA"

33. **HEMINGWAY, ERNEST.** (1898-1961) Great American writer. Awarded Nobel Prize in 1954. Works include *For Whom The Bell Tolls*, *The Snows of Kilimanjaro* and *The Old Man and the Sea*. Exceptional signed photo of Hemingway next to a huge buffalo he has hunted. The photo dates from January 1934 and was taken in Serengeti Plain, Africa. That same year, Hemingway wrote his famous book *Green Hills of Africa* about that safari and great game hunting: "Then the big one got up. There was no choice now.. I put my arm through the sling..and squeezed off on the center of the bull's shoulder...hit him as he ran..." Hemingway has inscribed the photo "*To Mary Sullivan, from her friend*", and has signed in full "*Ernest Hemingway*." The name "Mary Sullivan" has faded, but signature is very clear and bold. The book *Green Hills of Africa* was dedicated to three of his friends, including J.B. Sullivan. In 1936, Hemingway wrote his second book on Africa *The Snows of Kilimanjaro*, that idea also started in 1934. This photo captures a 35 year old Hemingway big game hunting in Africa. 34. **LOMBARD, CAROLE.** (1908-1942) Glamorous Actress, who played sophisticated leading ladies and wonderfully humorous comic roles. She was witty charming, sexy and funny Lombard was happily married to actor Clark Gable, and at the top of her career, when she died tragically in a plane crash at age 33 Her movies include *My Man Godfrey*, *Nothing Sacred* and *The Twentieth Century*. She was the highest paid actress of her time. 35. **DALI, SALVADOR.** (1904-1989) Eccentric Spanish Surrealist Artist. Known for his dream-like images. Signed color reproduction of four men looking over a beautiful woman with a huge profile looking from above. Dali has boldly signed on light background in upper left corner Below the image is printed "*Que ramo de bonitas cerezas!*" ("What beautiful cherries!"). Perfect for display \$95

36. **FROST, ROBERT** (1874-1963) Illustrious American Poet. Pulitzer Prize winner AQS. Frost quotes the second and third line from his poem *The Pasture*

*"I'll only stop to rake the leaves away
(And wait to watch the water clear I may)"
"Robert Frost"*

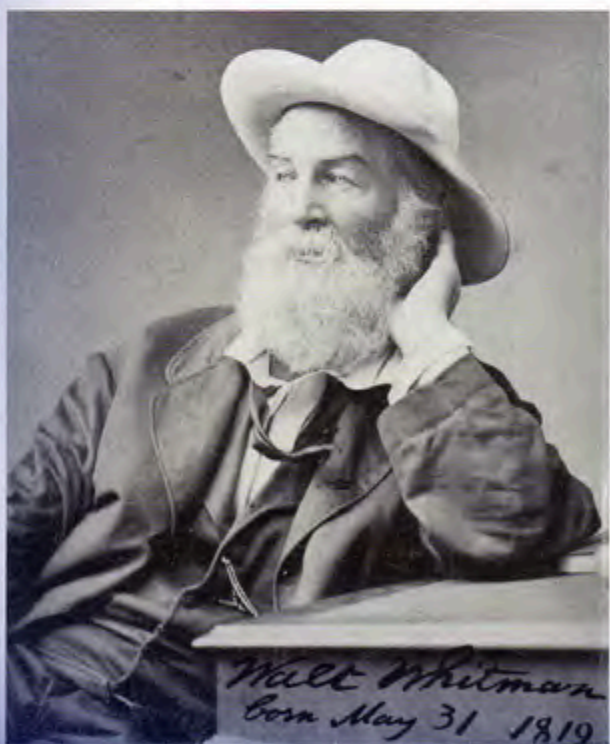
