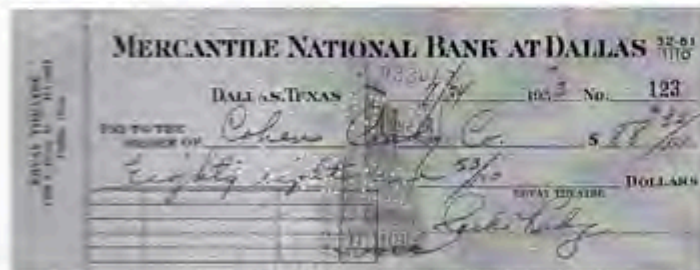
The famous Karsh photo of JFK and Jackie

This Watergate autographed archive is a one of a kind collection of autographed items including signed pamphlets signed cards & signed photos with signatures of the major players including Supreme Court Chief Justice "Warren Burger", Justice "Thurgood Marshall", Justice "William Brennan", Justice "Byron R. White". All were in the US Supreme court that voted against Executive Privilege defense of Nixon and forced him to face the consequences of Watergate. Also includes a letter from Watergate Special Prosecutor Archibald Cox, in part "...I was critical of President Ford's pardon of Richard Nixon at the time and publicly stated that in my opinion former President Nixon should have been forced to stand trial before a jury like anyone else .." 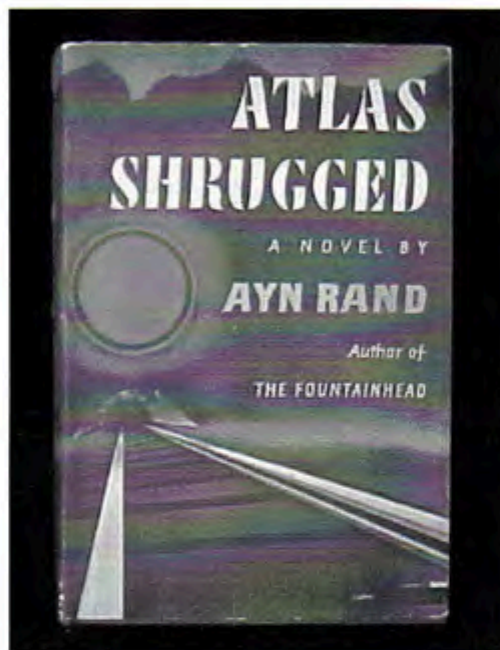

Publisher's green cloth with black label, gilt titles and motif to spine and front board, complete with dust wrapper. Signed and inscribed on front free endpaper very close to the date of publication. "Atlas Shrugged." was named in a survey by the Library of Congress as the second most influential book on American lives after the Bible.
