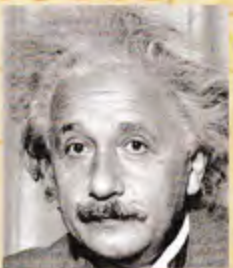

Sir

This letter will probably be presented to you by Mr. Tiddings. It is the son of a gentleman of that name who has been some years from France to the United States with a view of settling himself in some part of the western country, but on examining the abstract, was so far from being attracted by the prospect - It is reported to me that after the death of his father, and seeing the miseries of the war, the family was put on the list of emigrants by the then government of France, the latter having secured assurances that their names will never be erased from the emigrants' registers to visit his native country with a view of exchanging his respects to his Mother who is still living, and as far as may be practicable of redeeming his estate - Mr. Tiddings sensible of the high consideration attached to your name in France conceives that letters from you of his good conduct here, will speedily facilitate the execution of his object, and for this purpose has engaged a friend for a letter of recommendation to you - I do not think Mr. Tiddings' request will be the greatest honor to your country if it is a declaration of his own good conduct in this place - He is a man who has labored in the cause of his country - Mr. Tiddings is connected with his elder brother who has been for some time residing here in the mercantile line - Your house is in good credit, and as far as I am informed their conduct in every respect is respectable - Under these circumstances I have no doubt that as far as propriety will admit you

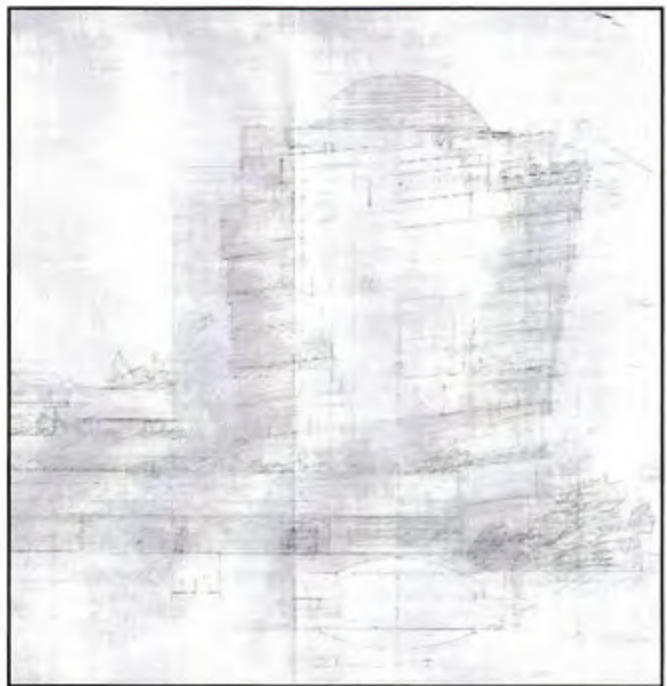


